The Southeast Missouri State University Shuttle Service was established in 1993 and operates in conjunction with a grant from the Missouri Department of Transportation. Service is provided daily during the fall and spring semesters.

The service continues to provide comfortable and convenient transportation to students, faculty, staff and visitors of Southeast Missouri State and has experienced ridership growth and facility improvement since its inception.

In 2003, the Service received the FTA Region 7 award for the Highest Percentage of Increased Ridership for 1999, 2000, 2001 and 2002.



PASSENGER GUIDELINES

1. Southeast Missouri State University's Code of Student Conduct applies to transit services passengers. (view at www.semo.edu)
2. The driver will give directions should an emergency occur.
3. Passengers should remain seated while the bus is in motion.
4. Arms and legs should be kept in the bus.
5. Objects should never be thrown at or from a bus.
6. Wait for a bus in a safe place, off the road, clear of traffic, and at designated bus stops.
7. Trash receptacles are located at the front of the bus.
8. Aisles should remain clear and the seats available for passengers.
9. Emergency exits are to be used only on the direction of the driver.
10. Transit buses are smoke free.

Medical equipment and service animals are permitted on this service.

Goes through Towers approximately every 10 minutes starting at 7:25 a.m.
Monday-Friday: 7:25 a.m.-8:00 p.m.; **Saturday-Sunday:** 4:00 p.m.-8:00 p.m.

PURPLE ROUTE

Goes through the MMTF approximately every 10 minutes
Monday-Friday: 7:30 a.m.-10:30 a.m.

SILVER ROUTE

Goes through Towers approximately every 10 minutes starting at 7:25 a.m.
Monday-Friday: 7:25 a.m.-2:00 p.m.

RIVER CAMPUS ROUTE

Goes through Towers at: Top of the hour :15 on the hour :30 on the hour :45 on the hour
Monday-Friday: 7:00 a.m.-midnight; **Saturday-Sunday:** 1:00 p.m.-midnight

GOLD ROUTE

Goes through MMTF every 20 minutes

CCTA REDHAWK PASS AVAILABLE TO STUDENTS

The Southeast Shuttle Service connects with several locations from which students may catch a Cape County Transit Authority bus (CCTA). These stops are along both River Campus Blue Routes and are identified in the route descriptions of this brochure. The stop at Sprigg and William is a CCTA Transfer Stop at which passengers may catch either CCTA's east route to Downtown Cape or the west route towards the Town Plaza and West Park Mall areas. Cape County Transit also makes connecting stops at various campus locations on its east route. These locations are designated on the route map above.

Student fares for CCTA bus service is .75 a ride, with a Southeast ID; however, a **Redhawk Pass** is available which provides one month's unlimited fares on any CCTA line. The **Redhawk Pass** cost is \$17.50 with a Student ID. Call Cape Transit at 573-335-5533, extension 10 for details.
